



SENIOR MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES – COMMITMENT TO FOOD SAFETY

The majority of Food safety standards e.g HACCP, BRC, ISO 22 000 and FSSC 22 000 requires that senior management is involved with and committed to the food safety management system (FSMS). It recognises that without top management commitment it would be unlikely that the FSMS would get the resources and support needed to ensure its effective implementation.

This course aims to provide top management with the necessary knowledge and understanding of their responsibilities towards the effective implementation of a FSMS.
