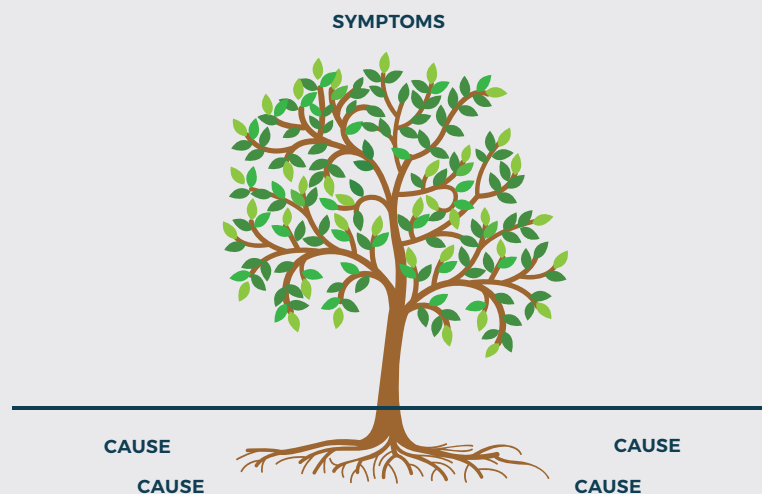

ROOT-CAUSE ANALYSIS AND CORRECTIVE ACTION TRAINING
